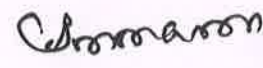

NOTE 1

1 Significant accounting policies and Notes to Financial statements:

1.01 General :

- (a) Operate and maintain power/energy/generating stations including buildings, structures, works, machineries, equipments cables and to undertake or to carry on the business of managing, owning, controlling, erecting, commissioning, operating, running, leasing or transforming to third person(s), power plants and plants based on conventional or non-conventional energy sources, bio-mass, solar energy plants, wind energy plants, mechanical, electrical, hydel and to deal all kinds of energy systems and products, such as electric power, thermal power, hydraulic power, wind power, solar power, compressed natural gas, cooking gas, coal, petroleum, diesel, kerosene including energy saving devices.
- (b) These financial statements have been prepared and presented in accordance with the accounting standards notified under Section 133 of the Companies Act read with Rule 7 of Companies (Accounts) Rules, 2014 and other accounting principles generally accepted in India to the extent applicable
- (c) All assets and liabilities have been classified and disclosed as current or non-current as per company's normal operating cycle and other criteria set out in schedule III.
- (d) Based on the nature of services rendered and the time between the acquisition of assets for processing and their realization into cash and cash equivalents, the company has ascertained its operating cycle as 12 months for the purpose of current and non current classification of assets and liabilities.

1.02 Use of Estimates:

The preparation of the financial statements in conformity with Indian GAAP requires the Management to make estimates and assumptions that are considered in the reported amount of assets and liabilities (including contingent liabilities) and the reported income and expenses during the year. The Management believes that the estimates and the differences between the actual results and the estimates are recognised in the periods in which the results are known/materialise.

1.03 Cash and cash equivalents (for the purposes of cash flow statement):

Cash and cash equivalents includes cash on hand and balance in bank current accounts.

1.04 Cash flow statement:

A Small Company is a private company with a maximum paid up capital of Rs. 4 Crore and a maximum turnover of Rs. 40 crores this company has a paid up capital of Rs. 1 lakh .its exempted from preparation of Cash flow statements as per AS 3.

1.05 Property, Plant & Equipment and depreciation:

Property, Plant & Equipment are stated at cost, less accumulated depreciation. Cost includes GST and freight. Depreciation has been provided on WDV method, in accordance with the provisions of The Companies Act, 2013, at the rates prescribed under Schedule II to the Act. Depreciation on additions and deletions during the year is provided on pro rata basis.

1.06 Inventories :

Inventories are valued at lower of cost or net realisable value. The cost of inventories is assigned by using weighted average cost formula.

1.07 Revenue Recognition :

Revenue is recognised when control of the goods or services are transferred to the customer at an amount that reflects the consideration to which the Company expects to be entitled in exchange for those goods or services, regardless of when the payment is being made. Revenue is measured at the fair value of the consideration received or receivable, taking into account contractually defined terms of payment. The Company is the principal in all of its revenue arrangements since it is the primary obligor in all the revenue arrangements as it has pricing latitude and is also exposed to inventory and credit risks. Revenue from the sale of goods is measured at the fair value of the consideration received or receivable, net of returns and allowances, trade discounts and volume rebates.

Rendering of Services : Service revenues are recognised when services are rendered, and when the outcome of the transaction can be estimated reliably.

b) Other Income:

Other Income Includes, (a)- Exchange Fluctuation Income , (b)- Interest on Income Tax Refund

1.08 Foreign Currency Transactions and Translations:

Transaction in foreign currencies entered into by the company are accounted at the exchange rates prevailing on the date of the transaction or at rates that closely approximate the rate at the date of the transaction

a)Initial recognition:

Transactions in foreign currencies entered into by the Company are accounted at the exchange rates prevailing on the date of the transaction or at rates that closely approximate the rate at the date of the transaction.

b)Measurement of foreign currency monetary items at the Balance sheet date:

Assets and liabilities(other than monetary items) are translated at the exchange rate prevailing on the balance sheet date. Non-monetary items are carried at historical cost. Revenue and expenses are translated at the average exchange rates prevailing during the year. Exchange difference arising out of these translations is charged to the Statement of Profit and Loss.

c)Treatment of exchange differences:

Exchange differences arising on settlement / restatement of short-term foreign currency monetary assets and liabilities of the Company are recognised as income or expense in the Statement of Profit and Loss.

d) Accounting of Forward contracts:

The company has not entered into any forward contracts to cover the foreign currency exposure.

1.09 Government Grants:

There are no Government grants, subsidies received or receivable by the Company during the period of accounting.

1.10 Investments :

Investments made by the company are stated at cost.No Investments have been made during the year. ,

1.11 Employee benefits:

Employee benefits include Salary, Wages, Bonus, Director Remuneration and Staff Welfare Expenses.

a) Defined Contribution Plans:

The Company's contribution defined contribution plans are charged as an expense as they fall due based on the amount of contribution required to be made.

b)Short term Employee benefits:

Short term employee benefits are charged off at the undiscounted amount in the year in which the related service is rendered.

c)Long term Employee benefits:

Employee benefits that are not expected to occur within twelve months after the end of the period in which the employee renders the related service are to be recognised as a liability at the present value of the defined benefit obligation as at the Balance Sheet date. Provision for long term employee benefits has not been made.

1.12 Employee Share based payments:

The Company being a Private Limited Company, the details to be furnished in terms of Stock Option Scheme has not arisen.

1.13 Borrowing costs:

Borrowing costs directly attributable to the acquisition, construction or production of qualifying assets, which are assets that necessarily take a substantial period of time to get ready for their intended use or sale, are added to the costs of those assets, until such time as the assets are substantially

ready for their intended use or sale. All other borrowing costs are recognised in Statement of Profit and Loss in the period in which they are incurred.

No such transactions incurred during the year.

1.14 Segment reporting:

The company is engaged in the trading and sale of Power and has only a single segment of operation.

1.15 Leases:

The company has not entered into any lease transactions during the year.

1.16 Earnings per Share:

The net profit for the Year is used as the numerator and the weighted average number of equity shares as the denominator in calculating the basic earnings per share. The net profit for the year has been used as the numerator and the weighted average number of shares after considering potentially dilutive shares have been used as the denominator for computing diluted earnings per share.

1.17 Taxes on income:

Current tax is the amount of tax payable on the taxable income for the year as determined in accordance with the provisions of the Income Tax Act, 1961.

Deferred tax liabilities are recognised for all timing differences. Deferred tax assets in respect of unabsorbed depreciation has been provided at current applicable rate of income tax on the timing difference between the WDV as per Companies Act and WDV as per Income tax Act, 1961.

Deferred tax asset relating to unabsorbed depreciation and business losses are recognized and carried forward to the extent that there is virtual certainty that sufficient future taxable income will be available against which such DTA can be realised.

Deferred tax assets and deferred tax liabilities have been offset wherever the company has a legally enforceable right to set off current tax assets and current tax liabilities and where the deferred tax liabilities relate to income taxes levied by the same taxation authority.

1.18 Research and development expenses:

The company has not incurred any research and development expenses during the year.

1.19 Joint Venture Operations:
